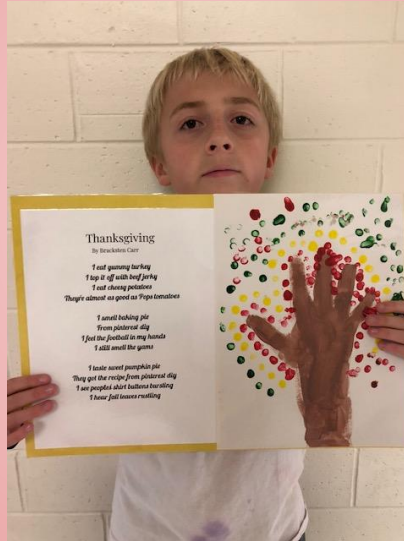

Thanksgiving

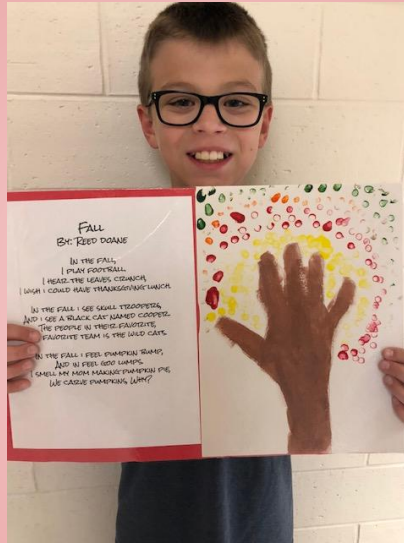

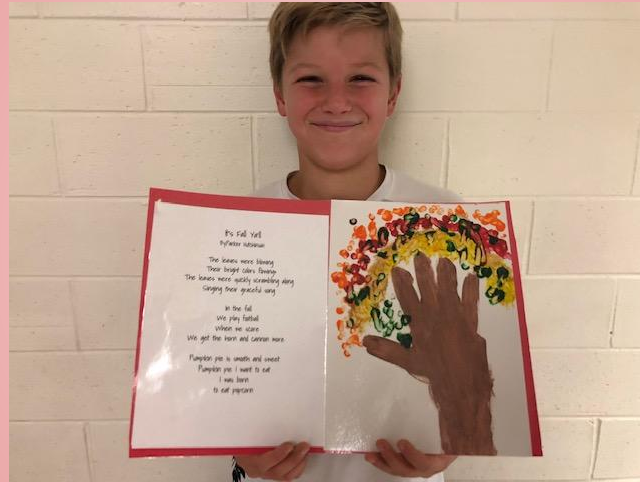
I see steaming turkey

And so we talk a lie

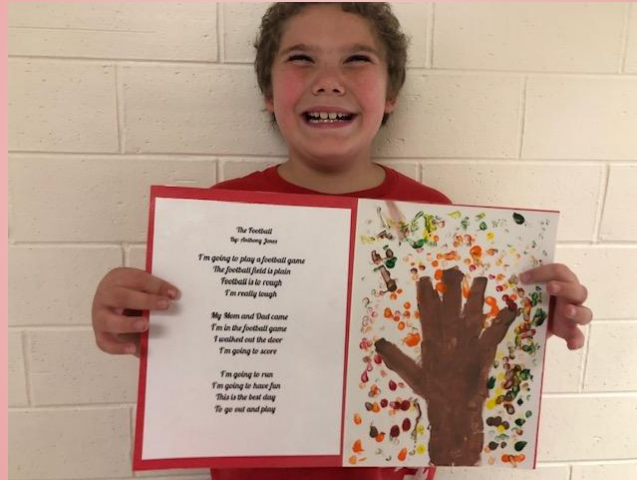

Because I don't want to be sad



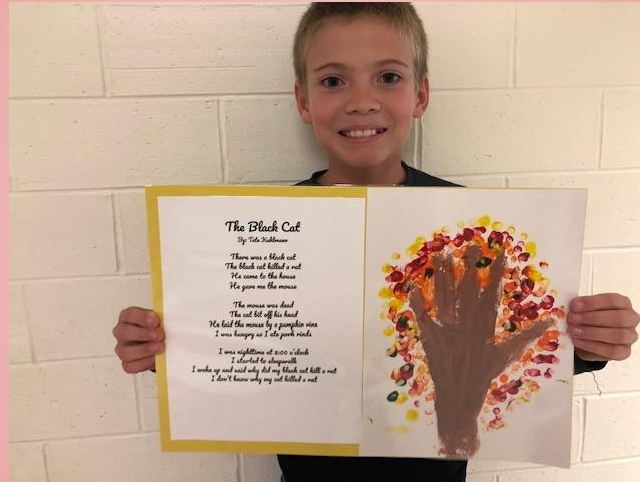

The Black Cat

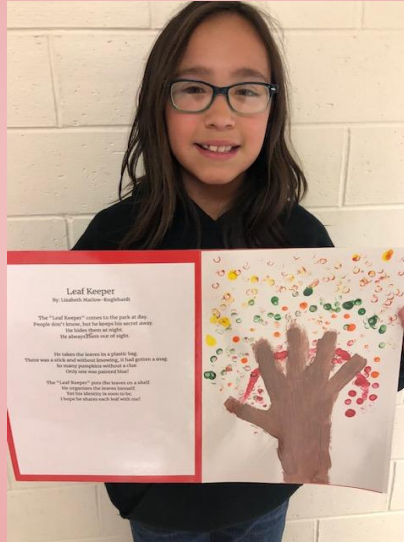

Leaf Keeper

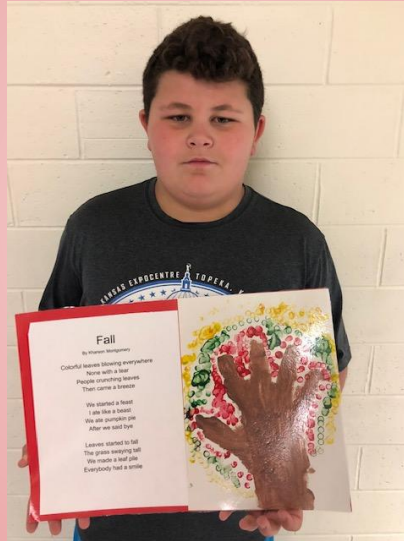

to show the way out of sight

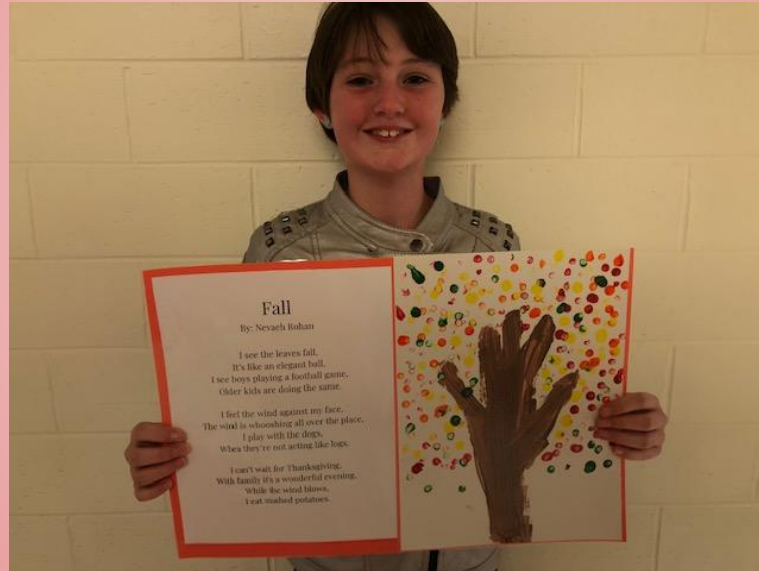

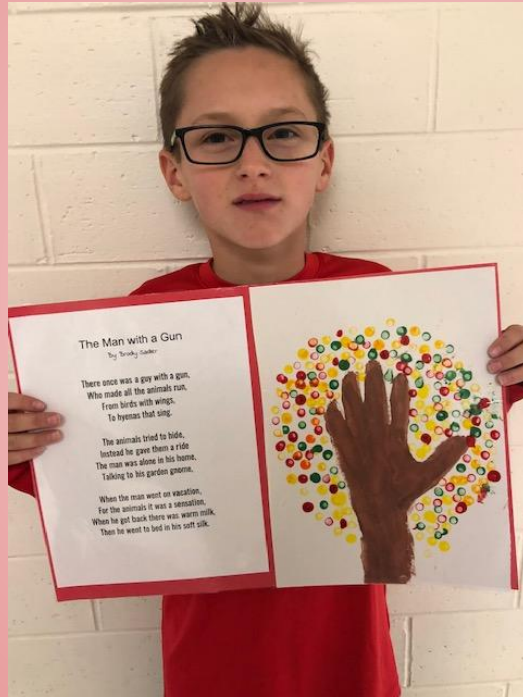

Older kids are doing the same.

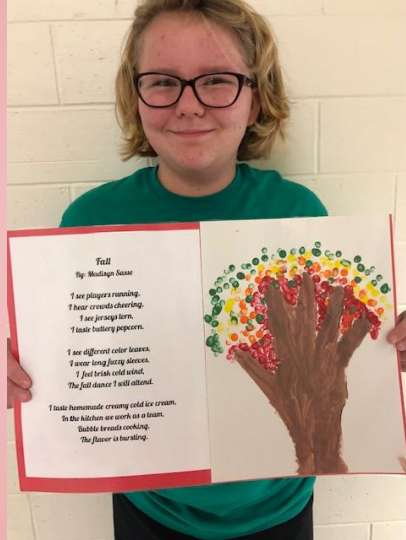

I eat mashed potatoes.

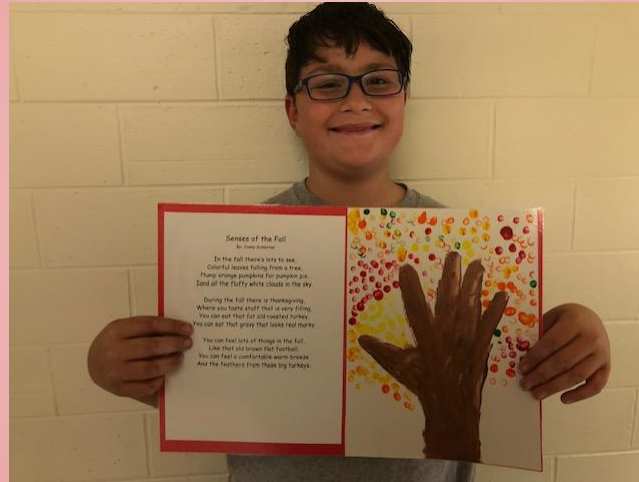

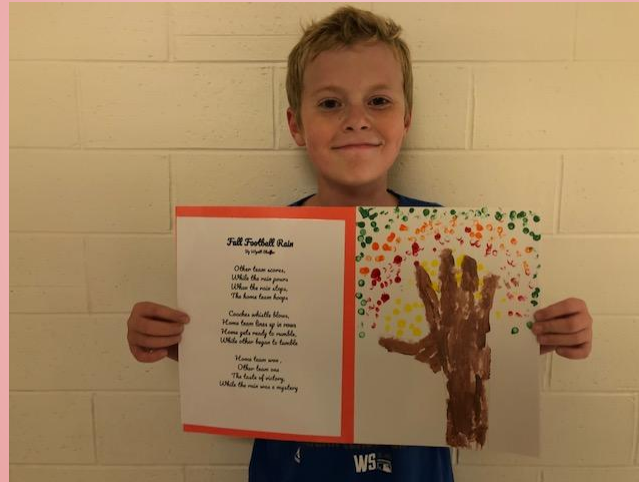
